NATURALIZATION ABSTRACTS OF McLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS 1853-1955

The Naturalization Abstracts have been published in seven volumes and may be purchased individually or as a set. Each volume has a hidden index of names that appear in the text of the listed individuals. These names are people who attest for the person to be naturalized or serve as a witness for that person. The names in the hidden index can also serve as a reference for researchers to document dates of persons who lived in McLean County. The cost of each volume is \$20.00. A full set of seven volumes is \$105.00. The cost includes shipping and handling. The seven volumes total 880 pages with 11,611 naturalization records and 4,593 names in the hidden indexes.
