It is also useful for agricultural history researchers and as a genealogical source for McLean County, especially Old Town and Downs Townships. Paperbacks are \$22.50

**BLO-2 Church Book for the German Evangelical Lutheran Combined Friedens Church, Bloomington, Illinois, 1884-1897.**

This is a translation from German of the first Baptisms, Marriages, and Burials. It includes a history of the church with photographs, an index of names, and an index of places of births. The indexes include 1733 names, 363 baptisms, 95 marriages, and 179 burials. The place of birth index includes 166 cities and towns in Germany, France, Lower Bavaria, Prussia, and Switzerland. The publication is 54 pages, side stitched. Cost per copy is \$12.00.

MCS-1 **McLean County Voters Who Petitioned for Sale of School Lands and Purchasers of the Lots 1831-1875.** This publication was originally published in the Quarterly as part of Spring and Summer issues of 1991. It is now being offered as a separate publication. It consists of over 1300 names listed from the original Record Book of the McLean County School Commissioner. It is 56 pages long. Cost is \$12 per copy.

MPR-1 **Index to Probate Records, McLean County, Illinois 1831-1946** The published index is alphabetized whereas the original is a chronological listing of surnames beginning with the same letter. The new index also has a hidden name index. In all there are six volumes: Volume I, A-C; Volume II, D-G; Volume III, H-K; Volume IV, L-O; Volume V, P-S; Volume VI, T-Z with some note of oaths made by county officials. Each book costs \$19.00; all six may be purchased for \$100.00 (a \$14.00 savings).

AABN-1 **African-American Residents of Bloomington-Normal, IL. 1885-1917** This database listing was created by Bill and Diane Detmers from 6,395 handwritten cards, transcribed by Caribel Washington of the Bloomington-Normal Black History Project from City Directories. This information includes year of publication, name, address, town name and occupation. The volume has 94 pages and paper binding. Cost \$17.00

MI-1860 **1860 Census of McLean County Citizens Born in Ireland, plus their Families.** This publication contains a listing, created by Bill & Diane Detmers, of the McLean County Citizens in the 1860 Census, that were born in Ireland and their families. It consists of 2666 entries including last name, first name, middle name, age, sex, year of birth, place of birth, occupation, township, census film number and census page number. The volume has 46 pages and has a paper binding. Cost \$12.00

MG-1880 **1880 Census German Immigrants and their Families in McLean County.** The data for this publication was created by McLean County Museum of History volunteers, William and Diane Detmers. This publication was transcribed from 7,382 handwritten entries from the microfilm copy of the census. This database contains last name, first name, relationship, age, year of birth, sex, birthplace, occupation, census place, census page number and comments. The volume has 156 pages and has a glued paper binding. Cost \$17.00.

**Latest Publications**

*The McLean County Combined Indexed Atlases, 1856-1914* was produced through the combined efforts of the McLean County Museum of History and the McLean County Genealogical Society. It was published by the McLean County Museum of History. The **hard bound** publication is 11 inches by 14 inches, 386 pages, includes in **color** the McLean County maps of 1856 and 1866 plus the 1874 Atlas of McLean County, Illinois; 1895 Plat Book of McLean County, Illinois; and the 1914 Standard Atlas of McLean County, Illinois. It includes a 54 page index of 22,706 landowners, businessmen, patrons, towns, schools, churches and cemeteries.

**Members of both Societies receive a 10% discount on the book.** The discounted cost for members is \$202.50 plus \$15.19 Illinois tax for Illinois residents. The cost for non-members is \$225.00 plus \$16.88 Illinois tax for Illinois residents. Out of state residents or tax-exempt organizations do not pay the Illinois tax. Shipping cost is \$10 per book.
